## More About This *Luxury Safari*

The Kruger National Park is one of the world's leading nature reserves and on a 3 day safari we spend a lot of time exploring the Park. Most operators only do 3 hour morning and afternoon drives, but the KNP is vast, and Kurt Safari was one of the first operators to introduce full-day safaris on our 3 day safari tours.

This gives clients a chance to see a larger part of the Kruger and different areas, compared to short 3 hour safaris which must remain close to camps, resulting in driving the same areas on every safari. Spending a full day in the KNP can sound tiring, but the guides stop regularly at rest camps and lookout points. The extended time increases the chances of seeing more wildlife as we traverse different grassland and ecological zones.

Your 3 Day Best of Kruger will include a sunset/ nights safaris on Day 1. A full day open vehicle safari and on day 2, and a morning safari in Kruger Park on Day 3.

80% of our clients on 3 day safaris encounter all the Big 5.

Kurt safaris makes use of Umbhaba Eco Lodge and Sanbonani Hotel situated just outside of Hazyview. These are 4-star privately owned quality lodges are less than 15 minutes from Phabeni Gate - Kruger's premier wildlife area.

### Departure & Return Location

06:30 am - 06:45 am: Clients will be collected from lodges within 5 km radius of OR Tambo International Airport.

06:45 am - 07:00 am: Clients will be collected from the Shuttle and Bus Terminal at the OR Tambo International Airport, please see the map below. We depart at 07:15 am. Transport to the airport is available via the modern Gautrian or Uber. Clients can fly directly into Skukuza Kruger National Park, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airports and be collected by your Kurt Safari Guide at no additional cost.

## Important Note

Clients flying out of OR Tambo on the last day to please not book flights earlier than 20:00 pm for domestic flights and 21:00 pm for international flights as one cannot always guarantee on-time arrival at OR Tambo International Airport.

Clients should arrive the day before their tour starts to avoid missing the shuttle to KNP, as this vehicle is not private and cannot be delayed.

We prefer the lodges and hotels outside of the Kruger Park as there is a bigger variety of accommodation and it is only 10-15 minutes drive to the nearest entry gate . All the accommodation venues are privately owned.

# Day by Day Itinerary

## Day 1

### Transfer to the Kruger National Park & an Evening Game Drive

We travel straight to the lodge in Hazyview, arriving around midday.

After settling in, guests can enjoy a light lunch, a refreshing swim, or a stroll along the lodge's walking trails. At 16:00 pm, we depart for an exciting sunset-to-night safari in a Kruger concession area, returning around 19:30 pm for a delicious dinner and a well-earned rest.

## Day 2

### Full Day Open Vehicle Safari in the Kruger National Park

Mpumalanga, the “place of the rising sun,” is the first province in South Africa to welcome the day, and the best Kruger National Park safaris start before sunrise. These cool, early hours are perfect for spotting predators and other wildlife. After a short drive, you’ll enter the park, where your guide will lead you to prime areas for sightings of the Big 5 and plains game.

Breakfast packs are arranged by the lodge, and about three hours in, you’ll stop for a coffee and bathroom break before continuing through the Kruger’s fascinating landscapes, which include rivers, bushveld, and open plains, all teeming with life.

Later, you’ll enjoy lunch (own account) at a rest camp, with time to browse the curio shop or sip a cold beer before heading back to the lodge. You’ll return around 15:30–16:00, just in time to unwind, swim, and enjoy a well-earned dinner.

## Day 3

### Morning Safari - Transfer to Johannesburg

On your final morning safari, we depart before sunrise once again, with your guide tracking down any animals still on your wish list, especially lions and leopards, most active in the early hours.

We'll pause midmorning for a packed breakfast and coffee before continuing the drive, returning to the lodge around 12:00 pm.

After saying goodbye to your guide and freshening up, the shuttle collects you at between 12:30 - 12:45 pm for the journey back to Johannesburg, arriving at OR Tambo or nearby lodges between 17:00 and 18:00.
