



4 Day Kruger & Panorama *Classic Safari*

The Kruger National Park is one of the worlds' leading nature reserves and on a 4 Day Safari we spend quality time on safari making the most of your time in Kruger.



More About This *Classic Safari*

This 4 Day safari experience combines thrilling wildlife encounters with scenic exploration. Guests are transferred from Johannesburg to Hazyview, where they check into the lodge and enjoy a light lunch before embarking on a sunset/ night safari in Kruger National Park.

Each day begins before sunrise to maximize wildlife viewing opportunities, with guided safaris exploring the park's vast 2, 000, 000 hectares, visiting diverse landscapes and eco-zones.

Meals include breakfast packs in the park and dinners at lodge, with ample time to relax. A full day is dedicated to the Panorama tour, showcasing the breathtaking Northern Drakensberg Mountain range, including attractions like God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, the Blyde River Canyon, and Lisbon waterfalls. The final morning features a 6 hour safari before returning to the lodge for the transfer back to Johannesburg.

This itinerary offers an exceptional chance to encounter the Big 5, with 90% of guests achieving this on the 4 Day tour.

06:30 am - 06:45 am: Clients will be collected from lodges within 5 km radius of OR Tambo International Airport.

06:45 am - 07:00 am: Clients will be collected from the Shuttle and Bus Terminal at the OR Tambo International Airport, please see the map below. We depart at 07:15 am. Transport to the airport is available via the modern Gautrain or Uber. Clients can fly directly into Skukuza Kruger National Park, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airports and be collected by your Kurt Safari Guide at no additional Cost.

Important Note

Clients flying out of OR Tambo on the last day to please not book flights earlier than 20:00 pm for domestic flights and 21:00 pm for international flights as one cannot always guarantee on-time arrival at OR Tambo International Airport.

Clients should arrive the day before their tour starts to avoid missing the shuttle to KNP, as this vehicle is not private and cannot be delayed.

We prefer the lodges and hotels outside of the Kruger Park as there is a bigger variety of accommodation and it is only 10-15 minutes drive to the nearest entry gate . All the accommodation venues are privately owned.

We cannot take children under 8 year old on shared safaris but please request a quote on private safaris.



Day by Day

Itinerary

Day 1

Transfer from Johannesburg & Sunset/Night safari

We will travel directly to the lodge in Hazyview and arrive between 11:30 am and 12:00 pm.

Guests will have time to relax, unpack, and enjoy a light lunch, and there is also time to go for a swim or for a walk around the beautiful lodge or its walking trails.

We depart at around 16:00 pm for a 3 Hour Sunset/Night Safari in the Kruger National Park on a private concession before returning to the lodge at approximately 19:30 or 20:00 pm for a scrumptious dinner, and a good night's rest.

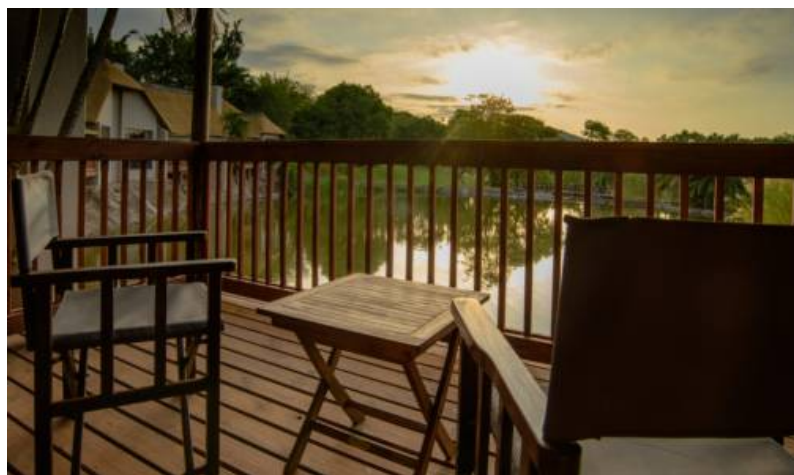

Day 2

Full Day Open Vehicle Safari in the Kruger National Park

All safaris start before sunrise as this is the best time of the day to enter the park. Not knowing what to expect, after a short drive to the park, we enter the park gates, and your guide will take you into an area that is popular for spotting wildlife. An early morning start will also give you a better opportunity to spot predators.

The lodge will arrange breakfast packs and after about 3 hours of driving in the park, your guide will stop for breakfast, a bathroom break, and a chance to grab a coffee. We then continue with the safari, exploring the Kruger's various eco-zones, each of which has different wildlife. We also visit rivers and watering holes as well as plains and Bushveld regions, all areas within the park that boast large wildlife populations.

For lunch, we stop at a rest camp. This meal will be on your own account. While at the camp there will be time to do some curio shopping or to indulge in a refreshing cold beer! The guide will then continue with the safari, as you make your way back towards the lodge. We arrive back at around 15:30 or 16:00 pm, with enough time to time to relax, swim and have a great dinner.

Day 3

Full Day Panorama Route Tour

Today's tour takes you to God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, Blyde River Canyon (the world's 3rd largest canyon), Lisbon Waterfalls, the 3 Rondavels and the town of Graskop.

We start with a delicious hot breakfast at the lodge at 07:00 am and your guide will meet you at 08:00 am in a closed air-conditioned vehicle.

The Panorama Route begins 45 minutes after leaving Hazyview. On our way, the route we take will have us climb almost 1000 meters up into the magnificent Northern Drakensberg Mountain Range. The temperatures up here vary a lot from Hazyview, so bring a jacket as well as comfortable walking shoes, as we do some lovely walks during the day.

After a day of sightseeing, we stop at the small misty town of Graskop for lunch and some curio shopping. The town is famous for its delicious pancakes, so we'll be stopping for lunch at the town's pancake restaurant. There are some great locally owned shops waiting to be explored and guests will have more than enough time to enjoy a stroll through the town.

We arrive back at the lodge at about 16:00 pm. There is time to enjoy a drink, have a cooling swim and then tuck into a hearty dinner at the lodge, before an early start for the last Kruger Park morning safari of the trip.

Day 4

Morning Safari and Transfer back to Johannesburg

This is the last safari of your trip and again we depart from the lodge before sunrise. During the morning, we will have another packed breakfast at one of the rest camps or at a picnic site.

On this day, the guide will focus on finding animals we couldn't find on the first 2 Kruger Park safaris. The Kruger National Park has 148 mammal species and over 500 bird species. We especially hope to see lion and leopard as they are most active in the early mornings.

After a short breakfast and coffee stop, we will continue with the safari, and we will return to the lodge at around 12:00 pm.

Here you say goodbye to your guide and freshen up before you make the journey back to Johannesburg. Clients will be collected by the shuttle at between 12:30 and 12:45 pm, and we will return to Johannesburg's OR Tambo Airport shuttle terminal and lodges within a 5 km radius, arriving between 17:00 and 18:00 pm.
