More About This *Luxury Safari*

The Kruger National Park is one of the world's leading nature reserves, and on a 4-day safari we spend a lot of time exploring the park. Most operators offer only 3-hour morning and afternoon drives, but the KNP is vast, and Kurt Safari was one of the first operators to introduce full-day safaris on our 4-day safari tours.

This gives clients a chance to see a larger part of the Kruger and different areas, compared to short 3-hour safaris which must remain close to camps, resulting in driving the same areas on every safari. Spending a full day in the KNP can sound tiring, but the guides stop regularly at rest camps and lookout points. The extended time increases the chances of seeing more wildlife as we traverse different grassland and ecological zones.

Your 4-day Kruger and Panorama Safari will include a sunset/ night safari. On Day 2, you will set out on a full-day safari. On Day 3, you will experience a full-day Panorama tour and a morning safari in the Kruger Park on Day 4.
80% of our clients on 4 day safaris encounter all the Big 5.

Kurt Safaris makes use of Umbhaba Eco Lodge and Sanbonani Hotel situated just outside of Hazyview. These privately owned, 4-star lodges are less than 15 minutes from Phabeni Gate - Kruger's premier wildlife area.

Departure & Return Location

06:30 am - 06:45 am: Clients will be collected from lodges within a 5 km radius of OR Tambo International Airport.

06:45 am - 07:00 am: Clients will be collected from the Shuttle and Bus Terminal at the OR Tambo International Airport. Please see the map below. We depart at 07:15 am. Transport to the airport is available via the modern Gautrain or Uber. Clients can fly directly to Skukuza Airport in Kruger National Park, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport and be collected by your Kurt Safari Guide at no additional cost.

Important Note

Guests flying out of OR Tambo on the final day should not book domestic flights before 20:00 or international flights before 21:00 for international flights as arrival times at OR Tambo International Airport cannot be guaranteed at OR Tambo International Airport.

Clients should arrive the day before their tour starts to avoid missing the shuttle to KNP, as this vehicle is not private and cannot be delayed.

We prefer the lodges and hotels outside of the Kruger Park as there is a wider variety of accommodation options and it is only 10-15-minutes drive to the nearest entry gate. All the accommodation venues are privately owned.

We cannot take children under 8 years old on shared safaris but please request a quote on private safaris.



Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1

Transfer to the Kruger National Park & an Evening Game Drive

We travel straight to your lodge in Hazyview, arriving around midday. After settling in, you can relax, enjoy a light lunch, take a swim, or wander along the lodge's scenic walking trails.

At 16:00, we set off for a spectacular Sunset–Night Safari in the Kruger National Park. In winter, the earlier sunset means more time under the stars, while summer guests enjoy golden skies and glowing horizons. We return around 19:30 to 20:00 for a hearty dinner and a well-deserved rest.

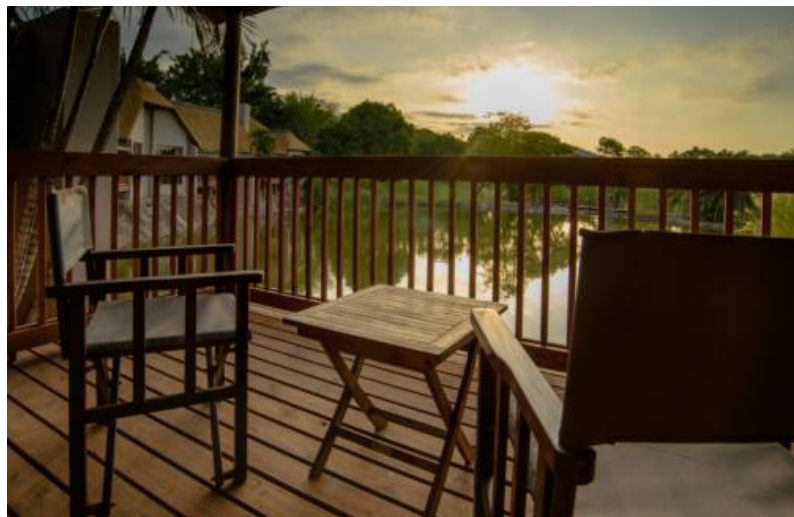

Day 2

Full-Day Open Vehicle-Safari in the Kruger National Park

Mpumalanga, the “place of the rising sun,” is the first province in South Africa to welcome the day, and the best Kruger safaris start before sunrise. The cool early hours are perfect for spotting predators and other wildlife. After a short drive, your guide leads you through the park's top viewing areas in search of the Big 5 and plains game.

Breakfast packs are provided by the lodge, with a stop about three hours in for coffee and a quick break before continuing through the Kruger's incredible landscapes, past rivers, bushveld, and open plains, all alive with wildlife.

Around midday, you'll stop at a rest camp for lunch (own account) with time to browse the curio shop or enjoy a cold drink and ice cream. The drive back to the lodge wraps up around 15:30–16:00, leaving you time to relax, take a swim, and enjoy a delicious dinner.

Day 3

Full-Day Panorama Route Tour

Guests get to explore the highlights of the Panorama Route, including God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, Blyde River Canyon (one of the world's largest green canyons), Lisbon Falls, the iconic 3 Rondavels, and the town of Graskop.

The day begins with a hot breakfast at 07:30 am, followed by a meeting with the guide at 08:00 am in a closed, air-conditioned vehicle. The drive climbs nearly 1 000 meters to the Northern Drakensberg, where conditions are cooler and often wetter.

Lunch and curio shopping take place in Graskop, a town famous for its pancakes, where guests can also browse local shops. The group returns to the lodge around 16:00 to relax, enjoy a drink or swim, and have dinner, preparing for the early start of the final Kruger Park morning safari.

Day 4

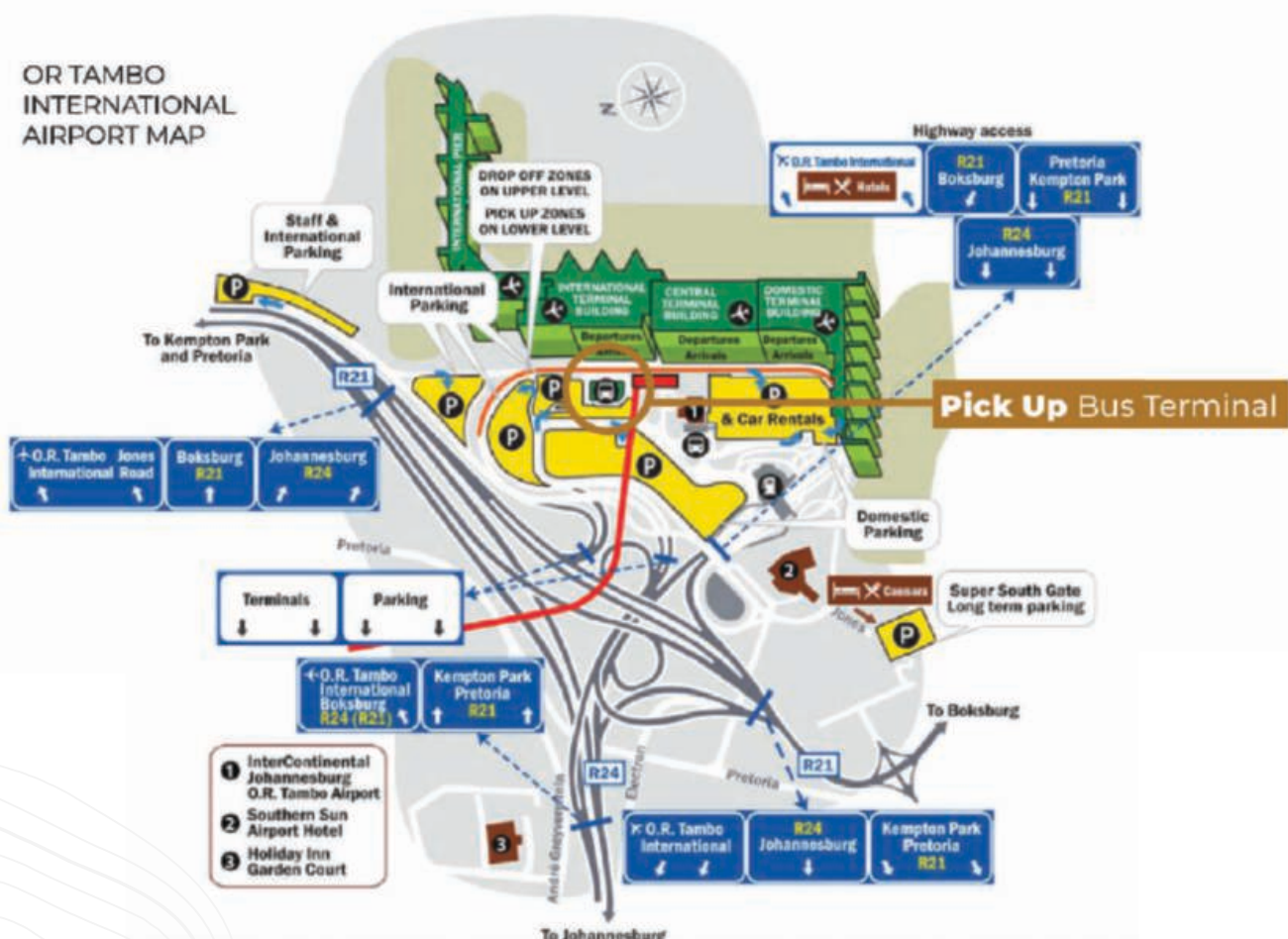
Last morning safari and transfer back to Johannesburg

The day begins with an early departure from the lodge, before sunrise, for the final Kruger safari. The guide focuses on spotting any animals not seen on the previous two safaris, with special attention to lions and leopards, most active in the cool morning hours.

After a short breakfast and coffee stop, the safari continues before returning to the lodge around 12:00. Guests can freshen up and say goodbye to their guide before being collected by the shuttle at 12:30 for the journey back to Johannesburg, arriving at OR Tambo International Airport or nearby lodges between 17:00 and 18:00.

11. Please note that we have a luggage restriction of 20 kg per person and a small piece of hand luggage.
