Departure & Return Location

06:30 am - 06:45 am: Clients will be collected from lodges within a 5 km radius of OR Tambo International Airport.

06:45 am - 07:00 am: Clients will be collected from the Shuttle and Bus Terminal at the OR Tambo International Airport, please see the map below. We depart at 07:15 am. Transport to the airport is available via the modern Gautrain or Uber. Clients can fly directly to Skukuza Airport in Kruger National Park, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport and be collected by your Kurt Safari Guide at no additional cost.

Important Note

Guests flying out of OR Tambo on the final day should not book domestic flights before 20:00 before 21:00 for international flights as arrival times at OR Tambo International Airport cannot be guaranteed.

Clients should arrive the day before their tour starts to avoid missing the shuttle to KNP, as this vehicle is not private and cannot be delayed.

We prefer the lodges and hotels outside of the Kruger Park as there is a wider variety of accommodation options and it is only 10-15-minute drive to the nearest entry gate. All the accommodation venues are privately owned.

We cannot take children under 8 years old on shared safaris but please request a quote on private safaris.



Day by Day

Itinerary

Day 1

Transfer and Sunset/ Night Safari

We head straight to your Hazyview lodge, arriving around midday. After checking in, you can settle into your room, enjoy a light lunch, take a refreshing swim, or wander along the lodge's scenic trails to stretch your legs before the afternoon adventure.

At 15:45, we depart for an exciting Sunset–Night Safari in the Kruger National Park, an experience that is certain to be a highlight of your time with us.

As the sun begins to sink, the bush comes alive with golden light, perfect for photography and spotting animals preparing for the night. Once darkness settles, your guide switches to a spotlight, revealing the secret world of nocturnal wildlife. This is when elusive creatures such as civets, genets, porcupines, hyenas, and even big cats become more active.

In winter, the earlier sunset allows extra time for stargazing beneath the clear African sky, while summer guests enjoy long, colourful twilight scenes and warm evening air. We return to the lodge at around 20:00, where a hearty dinner and a peaceful night's rest await.

Day 2

Private Full-Day Open-Vehicle Safari in the Kruger National Park

We start our safaris just before the sun rises. This is the best time of the day to travel to the park, and your guide will know just where to find the wildlife you've come to see, including the Big 5 and plains game. Early morning safaris are also the ideal time of the day to see predators.

The lodge will arrange breakfast packs, and your guide will stop after about 3 hours of driving for breakfast, a bathroom break and a chance to get coffee. We then continue the safari. The beautiful Kruger is home to a wide variety of eco zones and in each one, there are all sorts of interesting wildlife to see. During our drive we will visit rivers and watering holes as well as plains and Bushveld regions, all the areas that are best known for wildlife sightings.

We then stop for lunch at a rest camp, where the meal will be on your own account, and there will also be time to do some curio shopping or enjoy a cold beer! The guide will then continue with the safari as you head back towards the lodge. We arrive between 15:30 and 16:00, with enough time to relax, swim and have dinner.

Day 3

Full-Day Panorama Route Tour

Today's adventure begins with a hot breakfast at 07:30 am before meeting your guide at 08:00 am and setting off in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. The road winds upward nearly 1 000 metres into the Northern Drakensberg, where the air turns cooler and mist or light rain is common, adding atmosphere to the scenery.

You'll spend the day exploring the standout attractions of the Panorama Route, which include the otherworldly views of God's Window, the dramatic rock formations of Bourke's Luck Potholes and the majestic Blyde River Canyon, known as the world's third largest and the only major "green" canyon. Along the way, you'll also visit Lisbon Falls, the famous Three Rondavels, and the town of Graskop.

Lunch and curio shopping take place in Graskop, best known for its irresistible pancakes and friendly local shops. After exploring, the group returns to the lodge around 16:00 to unwind, enjoy a refreshing swim or a drink, and settle in for dinner before the early rise for the final Kruger Park morning safari.

Day 4

Last morning safari and Transfer back to Johannesburg

The day starts early with a pre-sunrise departure for your final Kruger safari. Your guide will concentrate on finding any wildlife you may have missed so far, especially lions and leopards, which are most active in the cool morning light.

After a brief stop for breakfast and coffee, the drive continues until returning to the lodge around 12:00. You'll have time to freshen up and bid farewell to your guide before the shuttle collects you at 12:30 for the trip back to Johannesburg. Arrival at OR Tambo International Airport or nearby lodges is expected between 17:00 and 18:00.

12. Shuttles depart from the OR Tambo Bus and Shuttle Terminal at 06:45 and collect from accommodation within a maximum 5 km radius.
13. Please request our list of accommodation venues available in the area. All lodges include a shuttle service to and from O.R. Tambo International Shuttle/Bus Terminal, it is very safe and clearly marked.
